Granting of the right to start and eligibility to participate in Hessian (HM) and German (DM) Championships

General right to start

1. Temporary right to start with approval from the national federation

Foreign nationals who have received authorisation from their national federation may join a club within the territory of the DLV.

The right to start may be granted during their stay within the territory of the DLV for no longer than the period authorised by their national federation.

2. Permanent right to start

Foreign athletes may be granted the right to start if, at the time of application, the athlete is a member of the club for which the right to start is being requested. If a LG submits the application, it confirms that the athlete is a member of one of the affiliated clubs.

Right to start (DLO, § 4.1.3)

- EU citizens are granted the right to start immediately.
- Non-EU citizens are granted the right to start if they have permanent residence or habitual residence within the DLV territory.
- If the right to start is requested for a non-German citizen, the approval from the home federation must be included with the application.

Participation at championships

Eligibility to participate in German Championships (DLO, § 5.2)

- German Championships are generally open to all athletes who hold German citizenship and have a valid right to start for a German club/LG.

Eligibility for the South German Championships

(General competition rules):

- EU citizens are eligible to compete in the South German Championships if they hold a right to start for a German club and have held it for at least one year.
- Non-EU citizens are eligible to compete in the South German Championships if they have had their permanent residence within the territory of the DLV for at least one year and have been eligible to compete for a German club during that period.

Eligibility to participate in the Hessian Championships:

- The Hessian Championships are generally open to all athletes who have valid right to start for a German club or LG.
- The regulations for non-German citizens that apply to the Hessian Championships must also be followed at district and regional championships.
